## Notes

1. Completing this Application Form registers your interest in obtaining a mooring only in the Dale Voluntary Controlled Area.
2. A **Private Licence** allows the licence holder to moor a **single, named, recreational vessel** within the Milford Haven Waterway.

A **Block Licence** is required if:

1. more than one vessel is to use the mooring, or
  2. the mooring is to be used by a **commercial vessel**
- For Block Licences, as in item 1 above, please state the dimensions of the largest vessel that will use the mooring.

- Private Licences incur a fee on first application; subsequent annual renewals do not incur a fee.
  - If you have more than one Private Licence in the Milford Haven Waterway then you pay a licence fee **each** year for **each** mooring.
  - Block Licences incur a licence fee each year.
  - Private Licence Fees vary from £37 (<5.5m LOA) to £72 (>7.5m <12m LOA) inc VAT.
  - Block Licence Fees vary from £75 (<15m LOA) to £5,356 (>30m LOA) ex. VAT.
  - A change of vessel associated with the mooring will require relicensing and payment of the appropriate fee.
3. Offers of mooring licences are made on the basis that the information provided on this form is correct. Incorrect or out of date information may result in an offer being revised or possibly rescinded on receipt of the actual mooring licence application.
  4. All vessels moored within the Milford Haven Waterway are required to abide by the conditions of the licence, Milford Haven Port Authority Byelaws and General Directions. Breaches may result in licences being revoked.
  5. **From 2012 all moorings will also need a licence from the Crown Estate for rental of the sea bed.** The cost is likely to be £23 for 2012, increasing to £63 in 2014. Forms will be sent out when they become available.
  6. Mooring tackle is not supplied or maintained by either Dale Voluntary Controlled Body or by Milford Haven Port Authority. It is the responsibility of the licence holder to lay and maintain their mooring tackle (use of a reputable contractor is advised).
  7. A mooring site is licensed to a **person** and their vessel and is **not transferable** to another person, for example on the sale of the vessel. However, in such cases, it **may** be possible for Dale Voluntary Controlled Body to allocate an appropriate site, depending on the state of the Waiting List.
